

# Four Corners

## What You Need:

- “Four Corners” Activity Pages
- Wall tape

## What You Do:

- Print the four pages of the Activity Pages.
- Hang one page in each corner of the room at your child’s level.
- Have your child stand in the middle of the room and say “We can tell \_\_\_\_\_ that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive.**”
  - You can say: doctor, police officer, firefighter, or teacher.
- Instruct the children to go to the corner with the picture of the person that you used.
- Continue the activity by saying the phrase for each picture and having the children visit each corner. Repeat as desired.

## What You Say:

“We have pictures around our room. There is a picture of a doctor (*point*), a firefighter (*point*), a police officer (*point*), and a teacher (*point*).”

“Let’s stand in the middle. Listen very carefully to what I say, and go to the picture that I am talking about. Are you ready? (*Pause.*)

We can tell a teacher that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive.**

Everyone, go to the corner that has the picture of a teacher. (*Pause.*)

Great job! Let’s do it again!” (*Continue activity.*)

“That was so much fun! We can tell everyone that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive.**

**Who is alive?**

**[Bottom Line] Jesus is alive!”**
